## **CLARIFICATION OF CERTAIN FACTUAL INFORMATION**

Canadian Solar (the "Company") issues this statement, following verification by Hogan Lovells International LLP, to clarify certain factual information erroneously reported regarding the Company's business:

- Canadian Solar does not have a joint venture with GCL-Poly. The two firms had formed a joint venture in 2014, but in 2019 Canadian Solar bought back all joint venture shares from minority shareholders, including GCL-Poly. This joint venture was located in Jiangsu Province, an eastern coastal province in China.
- Canadian Solar has no presence, including manufacturing solar modules or operating solar power plants, in Tumxuk and the Autonomous Region. The Company previously owned and operated a solar power plant in Tumxuk from 2013 until it was sold in 2021. Solar power plants are solar modules arrays that generate electricity when the sun shines on them and require limited labor for maintenance.
